PotashCorp Donates \$1 Million for New Recreation Complex in Sussex, N.B.

Sussex, N.B. – Potash Corporation of Saskatchewan Inc. (PotashCorp) today announced a donation of \$1 million to help fund a new recreation center to serve Sussex and the surrounding area.

In presenting a cheque, in Sussex, to the Fundy Civic Centre towards the \$3 million capital campaign goal, PCS Potash President Garth Moore said PotashCorp is proud to invest in people as well as the regional economy.

“As we expand our company to meet the expected growth in potash demand from around the world, our Sussex facility remains key to our operations,” said Moore. “With the expansion of our facility here, new jobs and business opportunities have certainly developed, but we are also pleased to play our part in enhancing this community where we live, work and raise our families.”

The new facility, which will be re-named PotashCorp Civic Centre in recognition of the corporation’s assistance, will cost an estimated \$6 million and feature a 25-meter swimming pool, a walking/jogging track and a fitness room with weights and exercise equipment.

Fundy Civic Centre representative John Robinson told people gathered for the announcement that PotashCorp’s donation goes beyond a contribution to bricks and mortar.

“PotashCorp’s generous gift provides an incredible financial boost to the success of this project,” he said. “In choosing to support a facility that will offer fitness and fun to people in our community, PotashCorp is also making an important contribution to our quality of life.”
