In fact, a total of \$3,047,716.41 has been raised to date. “John Robinson and his team of fundraisers worked incredibly hard to reach this goal and the board is very thankful for their hard work and belief in the project,” says Wendy Osborne, Chair of the centre’s board of directors.

The fundraising campaign was launched in the fall of 2008. John Robinson, campaign chairman, along with a team of division chairs, assembled committees of fundraisers who approached businesses and individuals for donations.
